Student data on Doddle

What data is on Doddle

- Your first name and last name; your school year; the classes you are in.
- Some schools also share your unique admission number.
- Your email address, if supplied by the school.
- Some schools send information about different groups you are in.
- How you are using Doddle – including when you login; the marks you receive on quizzes and tests; the time you spend looking at different resources; confidence ratings you give; RAG ratings you have received (if your school uses Doddle Progress).

What the data on Doddle is used for

- To allow you to access Doddle and use relevant resources.
- To enable your teachers to see what resources you have used on Doddle and scores you receive.
- To enable any parent accounts which are linked to yours to see when you last logged in, your quiz results, what homework you have been set, and any RAG ratings you have received.
- To produce reports on how often you are using Doddle and what you are doing on the platform.
- To match up information about how you use Doddle with other information the school supplies, such as results in certain assessments.

What data is on Doodle

- Your name and email address.
- When you last logged into Doodle.

What the data on Doodle is used for

- To allow you to access Doodle and use relevant resources.
- To enable a school administrator to see your account is linked to a specific student.
- Schools might also request parent data to see when they've logged on and how many times.
